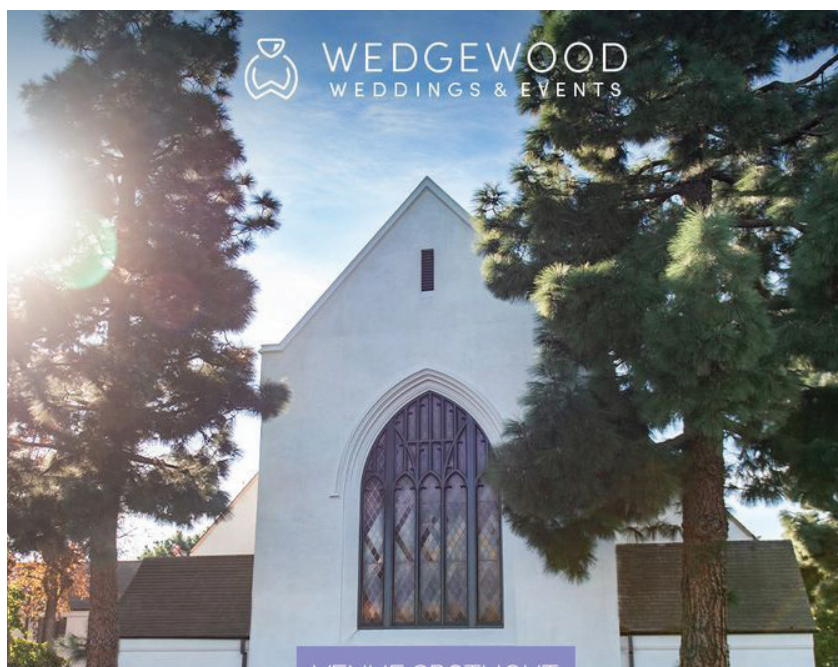

VENUE SPOTLIGHT

The Sanctuary
Long Beach, CA

From the north and west:

Enter Long Beach via the 710 and follow signage for “downtown” and then “West 6th Street.” Continue east on 6th Street to Atlantic Avenue and turn right. (6th Street is one-way eastbound, so when you leave you will need to go north on Atlantic one block farther to 7th Street [one-way westbound] and turn left to return to the 710.)

From the south and east:

Enter Long Beach from the 405/22 interchange by following signage for “22-west” and “East 7th Street.” Continue west on 7th Street to Atlantic Avenue and turn left. (7th Street east of Atlantic runs both ways, so you can return the same way.)

To the parking lot:

Once heading south on Atlantic Avenue from 6th or 7th Street, The Sanctuary is on the southeast corner of Atlantic and 5th (600 East 5th Street). Continue just past that to “Wedgewood Parking” (name of the company that owns the venue) and turn left from Atlantic into the lot at 402 Atlantic Avenue (opposite 7-Eleven). Parking is free.
